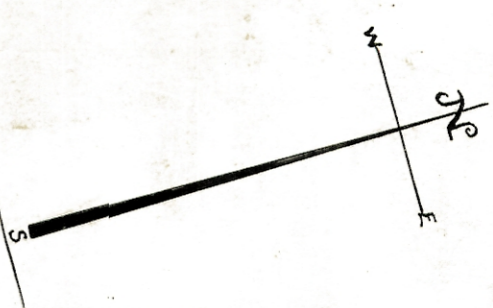




ENVELOPE: 191B
