to the South West Corner of a 48⁸³ Acre lot owned by the heirs of James Pendagap thence North to the North West Corner
of a 48⁸³ Acre lot owned by Albert Vorhes thence East 3 Chs 25 Chs thence North to the South line of Fraction No 3 thence
West 3 Chs 25 Chs to the South West Corner of said Fraction No 3 thence North to the North West Corner of said Fraction
No 3 thence East to the North East Corner of said Fraction No 3 thence North to the North West Corner of Section No
3 thence East to the North East Corner of said Section No 3 thence South to the place of beginning and bounded
entirely by the Present boundary lines of said Incorporated Village and including the whole of said Section No 3 all
of said Section No 2 (except the present Plat of said Incorporated Village 44 Chs in width of the East part of the
South half of Section No 8 and all of Fraction No 3 as more particularly delineated and specified in said accompany-

County Commissioners Office Athens December 3rd 1855. We the Commissioners of Athens County in the State of Ohio being satisfied that
more than ten qualified voters actually residing within the limits prescribed in the foregoing petition and having a free hold
interest therein having signed the same and that said signers are a majority of the voters and free holders residing within the limits and
that said limits have been accurately described and an accurate Plat thereof made and filed as required by law and it being deemed right
and proper in our judgment and discretion that said Petition should be granted do order that the territory described in said Petition may
be annexed to and become a part of the Incorporated Village of Albany in said Athens County.

Ordered that certain Territory may be
annexed to the Incorporated Village of Albany in said Athens County Ohio agreeably to a Petition of the qualified voters of said Territory for the
purpose dated July 2nd 1855 and whereas it being required by law that the question of said Annexation shall be submitted to the qualified
voters of said Village at the regular annual Election of the Municipal Officers of said Village whether such Annexation shall be made
or not that each voter at the Election of the Municipal Officers
of said Village on Monday the 7th day of April next at the School House in said Albany who is in favor of said Annexation shall endorse
on the back of his ticket Annexation Yes and that each voter who is opposed to said Annexation shall endorse on the back of his ticket
Annexation No. - Albert Vorhes Mayor. H. Wells. Recorder. Abstract of votes Recorders Office May 30th at the Election of Municipal
Officers of the incorporated Village of Albany Athens County Ohio held April 7th 1856 there were twenty votes endorsed Annexation Yes and none endorsed Annexation

30th 1856 Whereas a petition dated the 2nd day of July 1856 was presented to the Commissioners of Athens County Ohio requesting the annexation of certain
territory therein described to the Incorporated Village of Albany in Lee Township in said Athens County and as said request was granted by said Com-
missioners on the 3rd day of December 1855 and whereas on the 7th day of April 1856 at the Annual Election of the Municipal Officers of said Village a vote was taken on said annexa-
tion which resulted in a unanimous vote in favor thereof. Therefore Be it Ordained by the Mayor Recorder and Trustees of the Incorporated Village
of Albany that the Territory described in the above named petition has been annexed to and is a part of said Incorporated Village of Albany
