

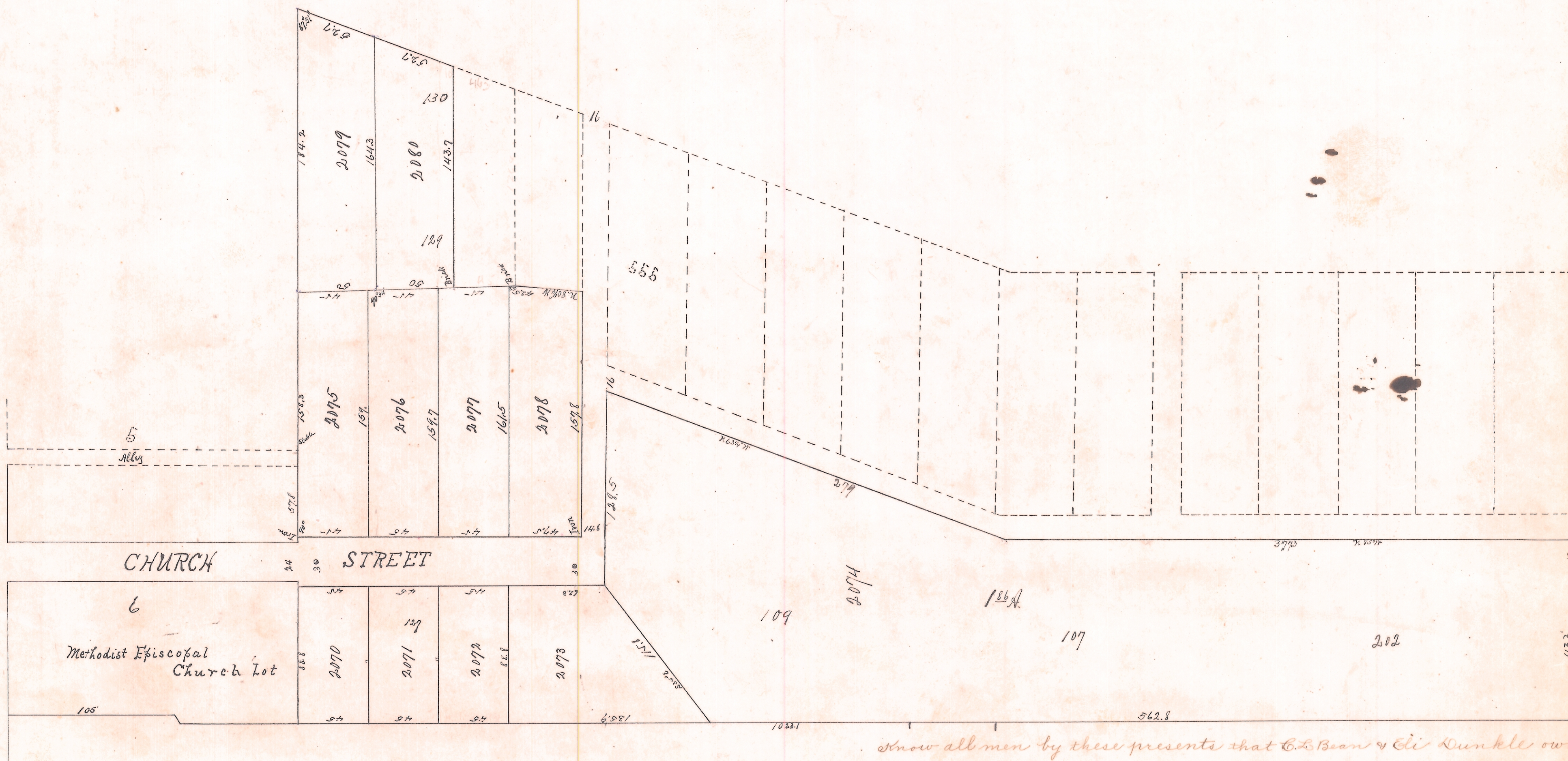
BEAN and DUNKLE ADDITION TO ATHENS, OHIO.
