BOWKLEY & JAMES' ADDITION TO THE VILLAGE OF GLOUSTER, ATHENS CO., O.

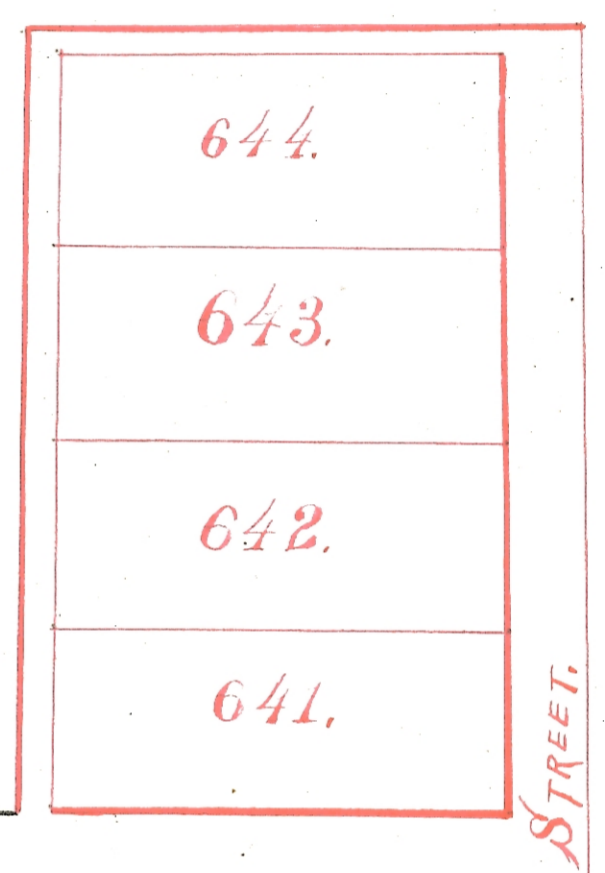

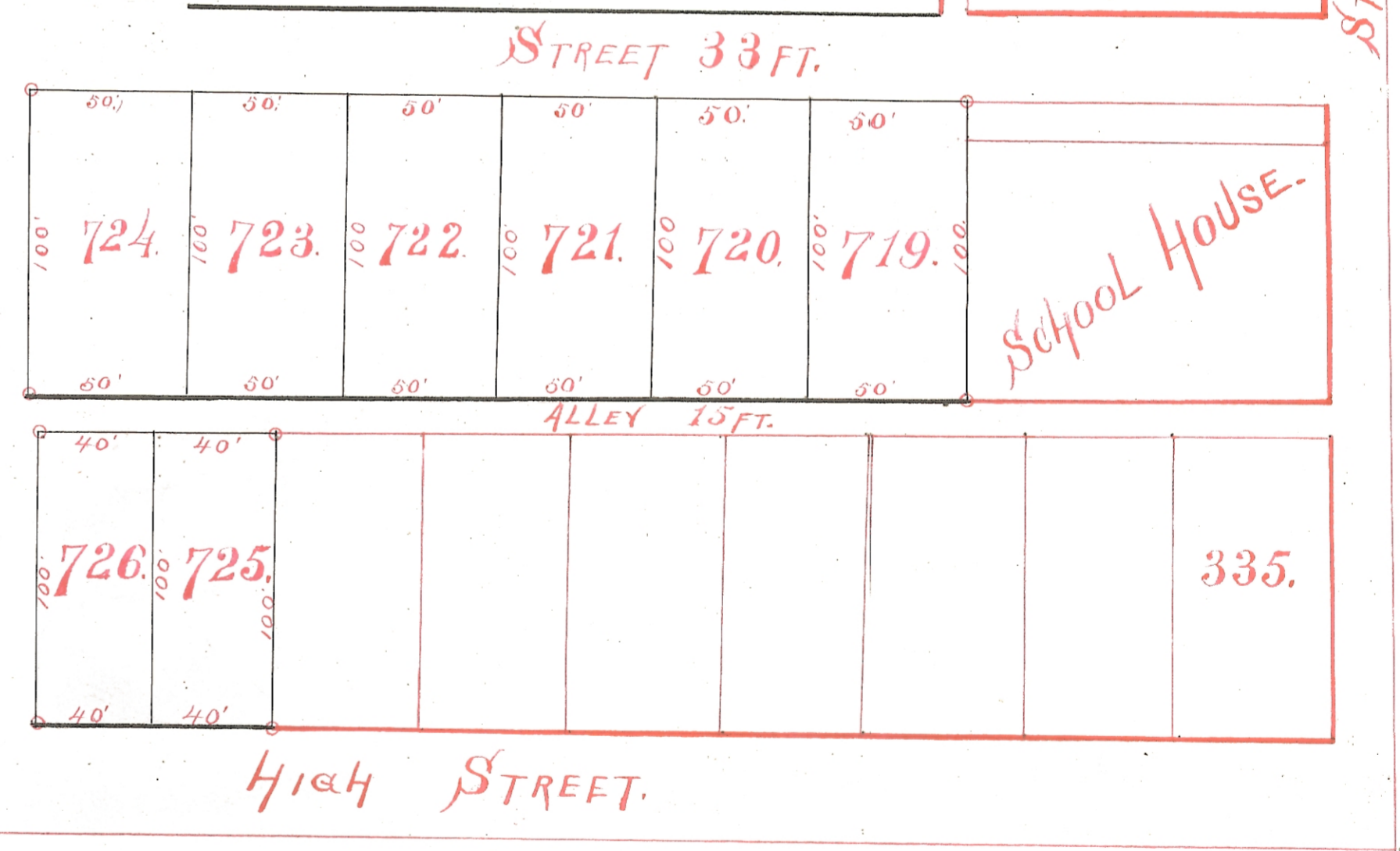
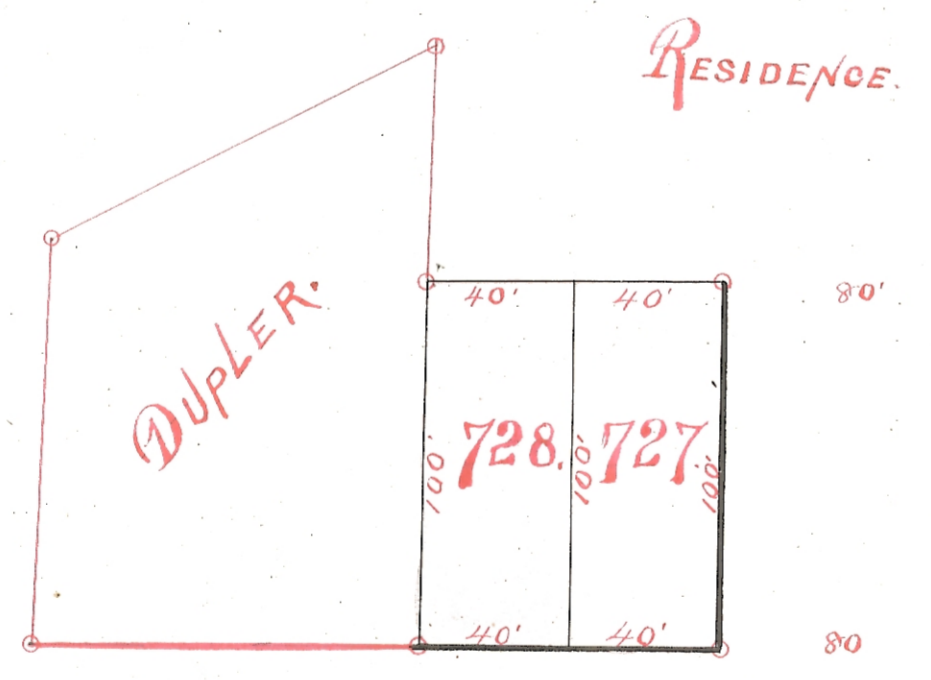
