Special Session February 8th A.D. 1900.

In the matter of the application of certain petitioners for the incorporation of certain territory into a village to be styled the Village of Buchtel.

On this day the matter of the application of certain petitioners for the incorporation of certain territory into a village to be styled the Village of Buchtel, came on to be heard before the Board of Commissioners of Athens County, Ohio, said Board, after hearing the evidence finds:

First - The petition contains all the matters required by law.

Second - The statements of the petition are true.

Third - The name proposed is appropriate.

Fourth - The limits of the proposed incorporation are accurately described and are not unreasonably large or small.

Fifth - The plat of said territory is accurate.

Sixth - The persons whose names are subscribed to the petition are electors residing in said territory.

Seventh - Notice of the application to organize and incorporate said village has been given as required by law.

Eighth - There is the requisite population for the proposed incorporation.

It is hereby ordered that said proposed incorporation may be organized.
