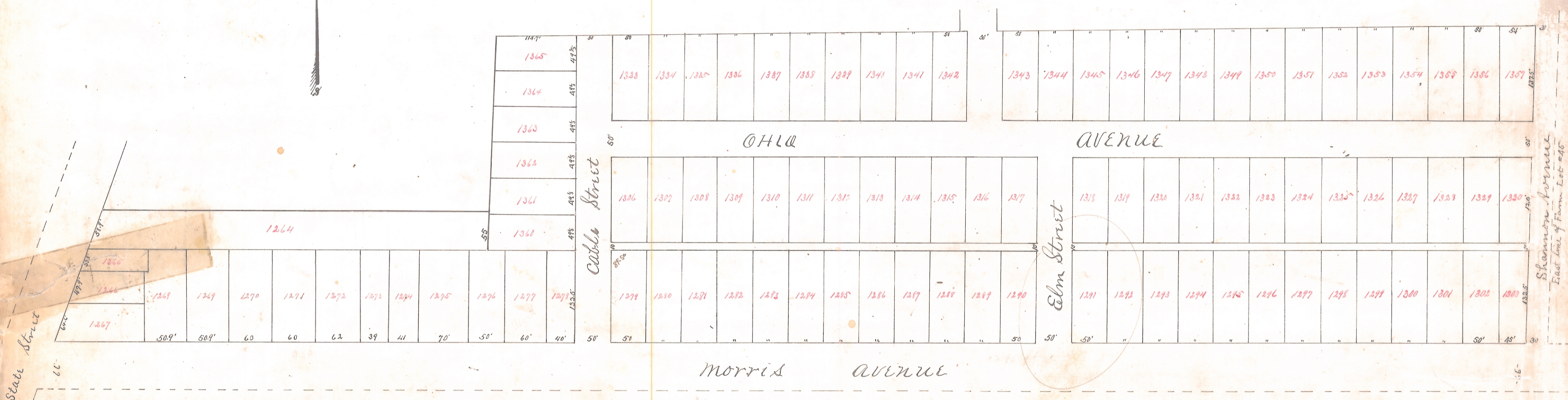
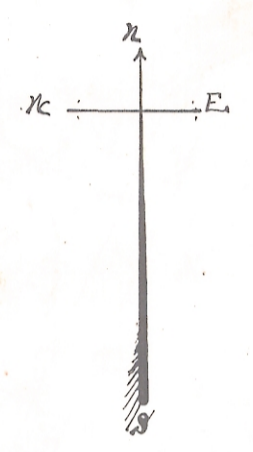
AMENDED PLAT OF CABLE HEIRS ADDITION ATHENS
