Amended Petition

To the Commissioners of Athens County, Ohio.
The undersigned electors, residing within the limits of the territory hereinafter described, hereby make application for the incorporation of the territory hereinafter described, into a village.

Said territory is described as follows:-

(1) Beginning at the North West corner of River Lot No. 345, Dover Township, Athens County, Ohio; thence South, following the West line of said Lot to the North line of Lot No. 699, in Chauncey; thence West, following the North line of said Lot No. 699, Lot No. 700-701 and 702 to the North East corner of Lot No. 703; thence West and South West, following the North line of Lot No. 703 to the East line of Lot No. 704; thence following the line of said Lots No. 704 and 705 in a South Westly direction to the South West corner of Lot No. 705; thence in a South Westly direction to the North West corner of Lot No. 716; thence following the line of Lot 714 in a South Westly direction to the South West corner thereof; thence in a South Westly direction to the North line of Lot No. 730; thence following the line of Lot No. 730 to the South West
