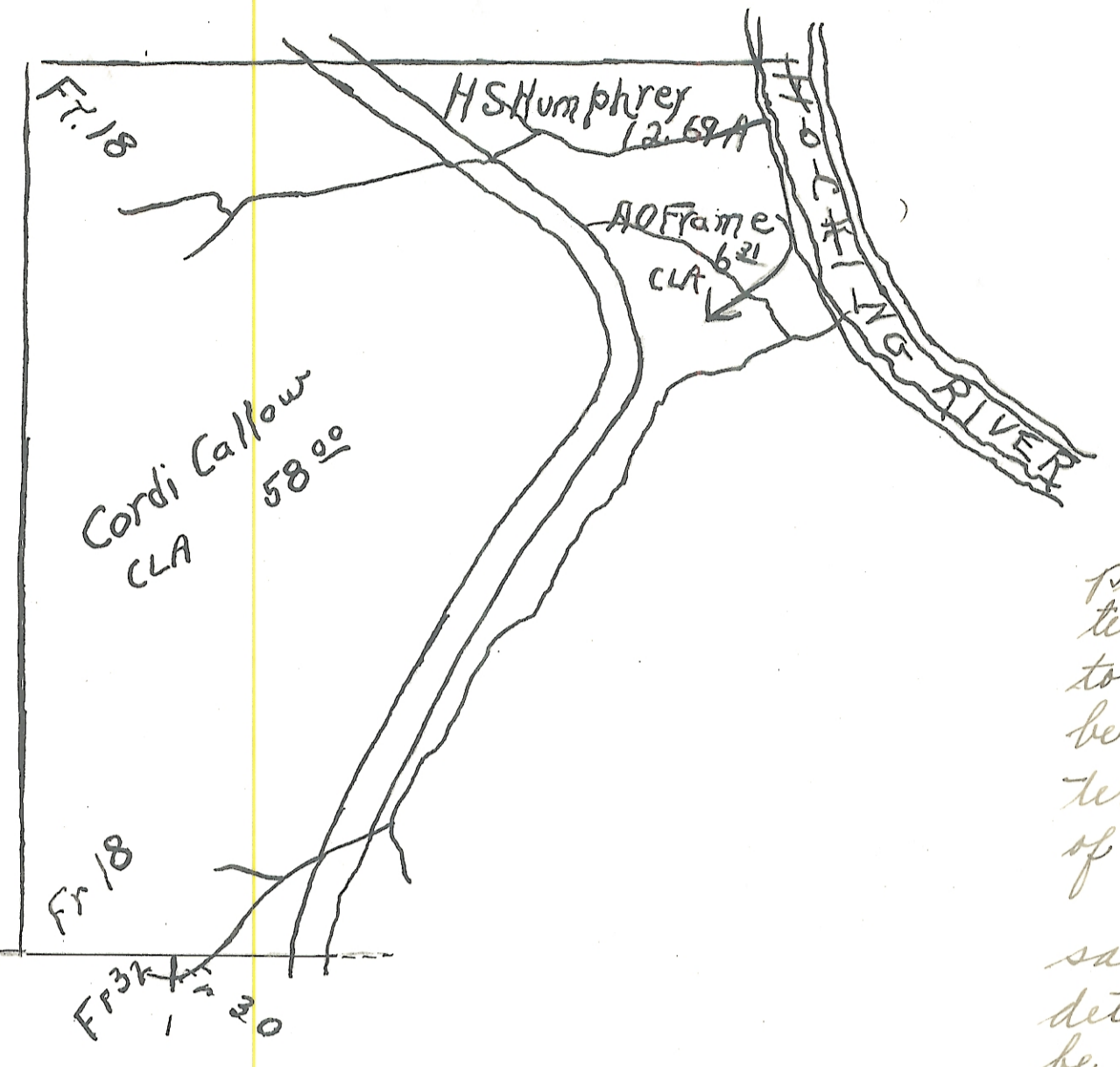
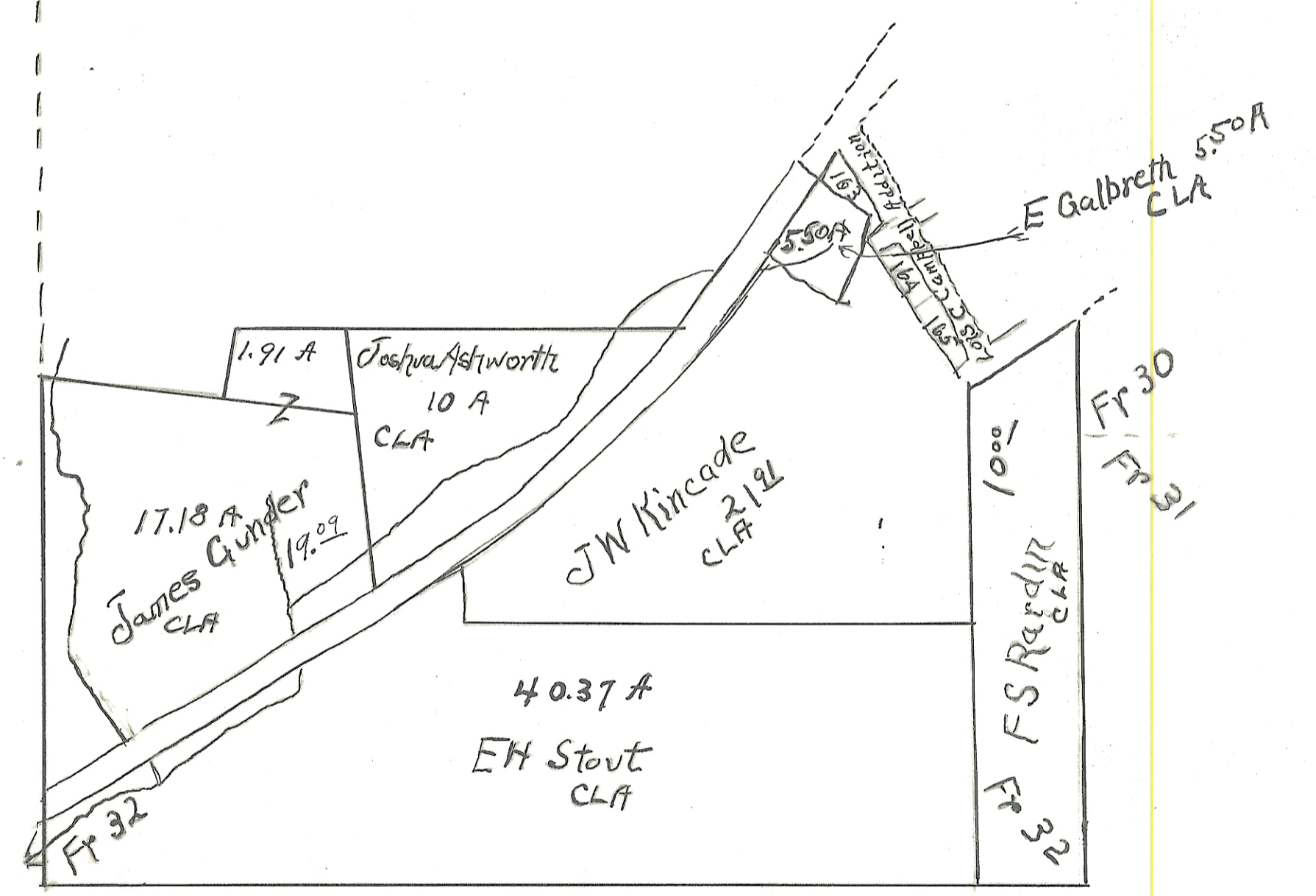

Ordinance No. 144.
Authorizing the Detachment of Certain Territory

Whereas, on the 21st day of November, 1923, a petition signed by all the owners of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to Council praying that the necessary legislation be passed authorizing the detachment of said territory and its annexation to the Township of Troy;

Whereas, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such detachment as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be authorized, now therefore,

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Coolville, State of Ohio.

Section I. That the owners of the following described territory situate in the Village of Coolville, County of Athens and State of Ohio, to-wit:

First Tract: Beginning at the Southeast corner of Fraction No. 32; thence North to Lois C. Campbell's addition; whence Southwest along the said Addition to the Southwest corner thereof; thence Northwest along the West line of Lots No. 165, 164 and 163 to point on the West side of pike opposite the Northwest corner of Lot No. 163; thence Southwest along West side of pike to the South line of Mary A. Jackson's Addition; thence West along South line of said Addition prolonged to the Northwest corner of 1.91 acre tract; thence South along West line of said tract to Jas. Gunder's north line; thence West along said North line to West line of Fraction No. 32, and old corporation line; thence following old corporation line to Southwest corner of Fraction No. 32; thence East to place of beginning.

Second Tract: Beginning at the Southeast corner of Fraction No. 18; thence east along South line of said Fraction No. 18 to creek;

of Troy; that the required legal notice of the petition has been given, and that it is right and proper that said petition should be granted.

It is hereby ordered that the prayer of said petition be granted, and that the territory described in said petition be detached from the Village of Coolville and annexed to the Township of Troy, in accordance with law, and that a certified transcript signed by a Majority of this Board of all the orders and proceedings of this Board relative to said petition and hearing thereon, together with said petition, map and ordinance attached thereto, and all the papers on file relating to said matter be deposited with the County Auditor for his certification and thereupon recorded in the Plat Book in the office of the County Recorder.

The Board of C. Commissioners met in regular session with members present: A. K. Johnson, Andrew Murphy and J. W. Hawk. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Motion by Mr. Murphy. The Commissioners of the County of Athens, State of Ohio, proceeding this day to hear the petition of J. W. Kincaid and others to obtain the detachment of the territory in their petition described from the Village of Coolville and its annexation to the township of Troy and having in open meeting heard all the persons desiring to be heard for or against the granting of said petition and considered the affidavits presented with reference thereto, and having carefully examined copy of the ordinance filed with petition and being fully advised that said ordinance was duly passed and by its terms assented to the detachment of the territory in the petition, contains all the matter required by law, that its statements are true; that the territory is adjacent to the said township of Troy; that the petition contains a description of said territory; that the map of said territory attached to said petition is accurate; that said petition is signed by the majority of the freeholder electors owning lands in said territory sought to be detached from the Village of Coolville and attached to the Township of Troy, in said County and State.

First Tract Beginning at the Southeast corner of Fraction No. 22; thence North to Lois C. Campbell's Addition; thence Southwest along the said Addition to the Southwest corner thereof; thence Northwest along the West line of lots No. 165, 164 and 163 to point on the West side of pike opposite the Northwest corner of lot No. 163; thence Southwest along West side of pike to the South line of Mary A. Jackson's Addition; thence West along South line of said Addition prolonged to the Northwest corner of 1.91 acre tract; thence South along West line of said tract to Jas. Sunder's N. line; thence West along long said North line to West line of Fraction No. 32; and old corporation line; thence following old corporation line to Southwest corner of Fraction No. 32, thence east to place of beginning.

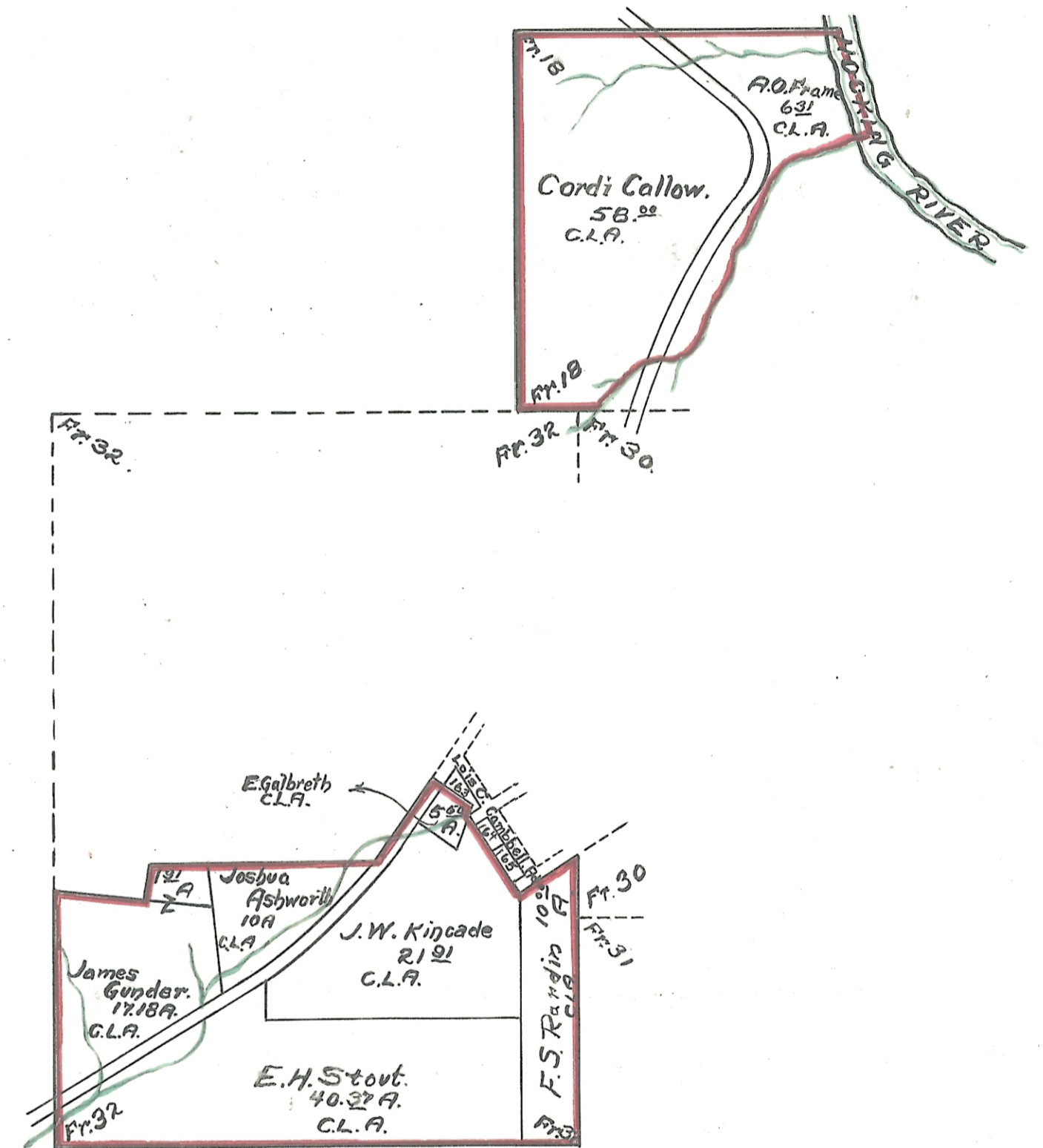
