

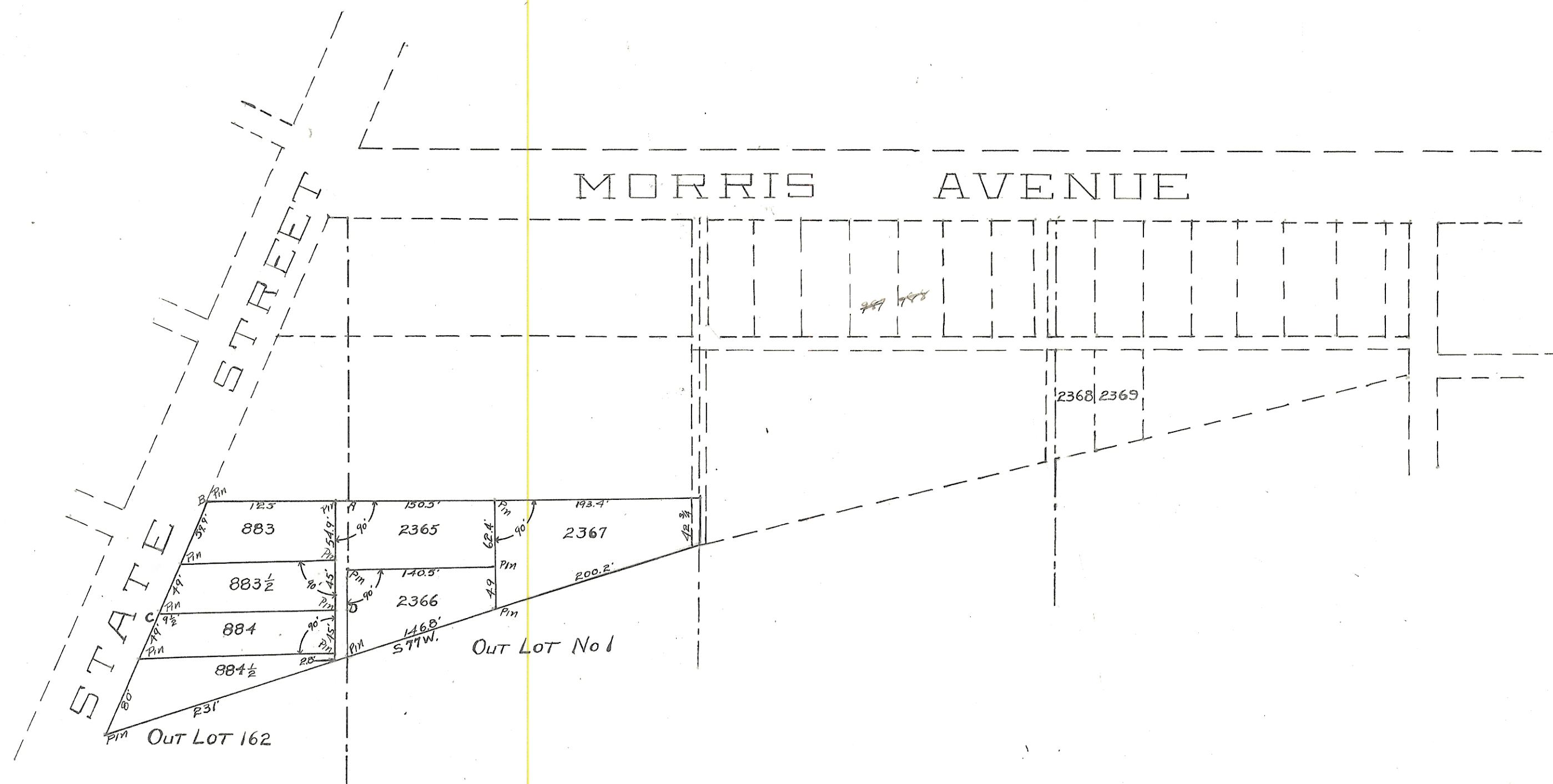
AMENDED PLAT OF THAT PORTION OF CORNWELL'S ADDITION
