The Village of Coolville Station is laid out on the North side of Baltimore Short Line Railroad Road, on the west side of the east half of the S.E. qr of sec 23 Town 5 Range 11, O.C.P.

The S.W. corner of lot no 1, is a stone marked "a" vis fifty feet N from the center of the sd RR. The streets are irregular corresponding with R.R. & Lay of the land

The lots are irregular in shape & size corresponding also with Roads and shape of the land, and contain from  $\frac{2}{100}$  to  $\frac{139}{100}$  acres
