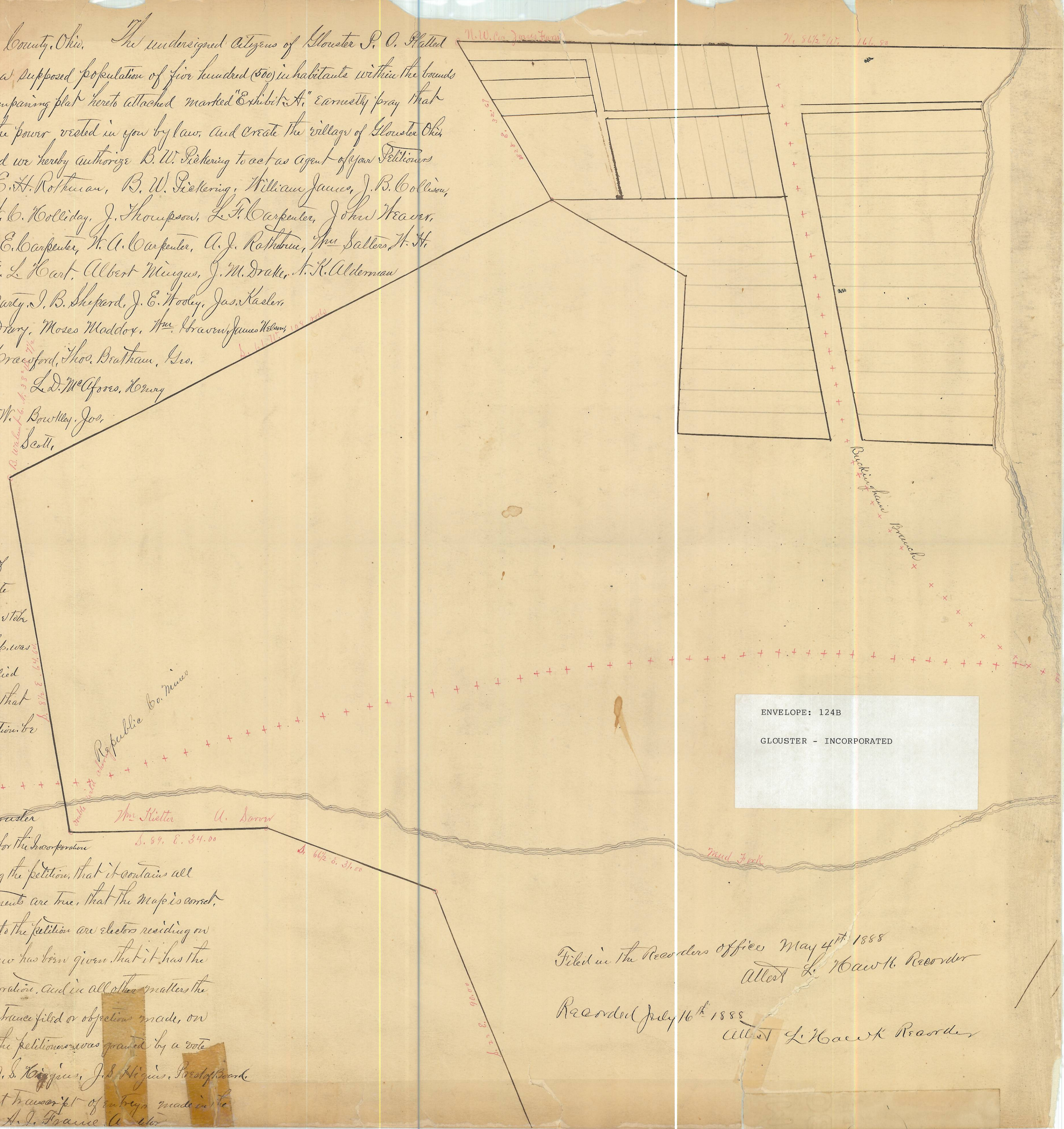
A petition signed by the requisite number of Electors residing within the proposed corporate limits asking for the organization of a village to be known as "Gloucester" in Triable Township, was presented, and the petitioners having complied with the law, therefore be it resolved that the time and place for hearing the petition be at Athens, May 4th 1888.

In the matter of the Petition of Citizens of Gloucester through their Agent, Dr. B. W. Pickering, for the incorporation of said village, the Board find upon hearing the petition, that it contains all the matters required, and that its statements are true, that the map is correct, that the persons whose names are subscribed to the petition are electors residing on the territory, that the notice as required by law has been given, that it has the requisite population for the proposed incorporation, and in all other matters the law has been complied with, and no remonstrance filed or objection made, on the part of J. A. Campbell. The prayer of the petitioners was granted by a vote of 10 yeas, 0 nays, J. A. Campbell and J. S. Higgins, J. D. Higgins, Pres of Board.

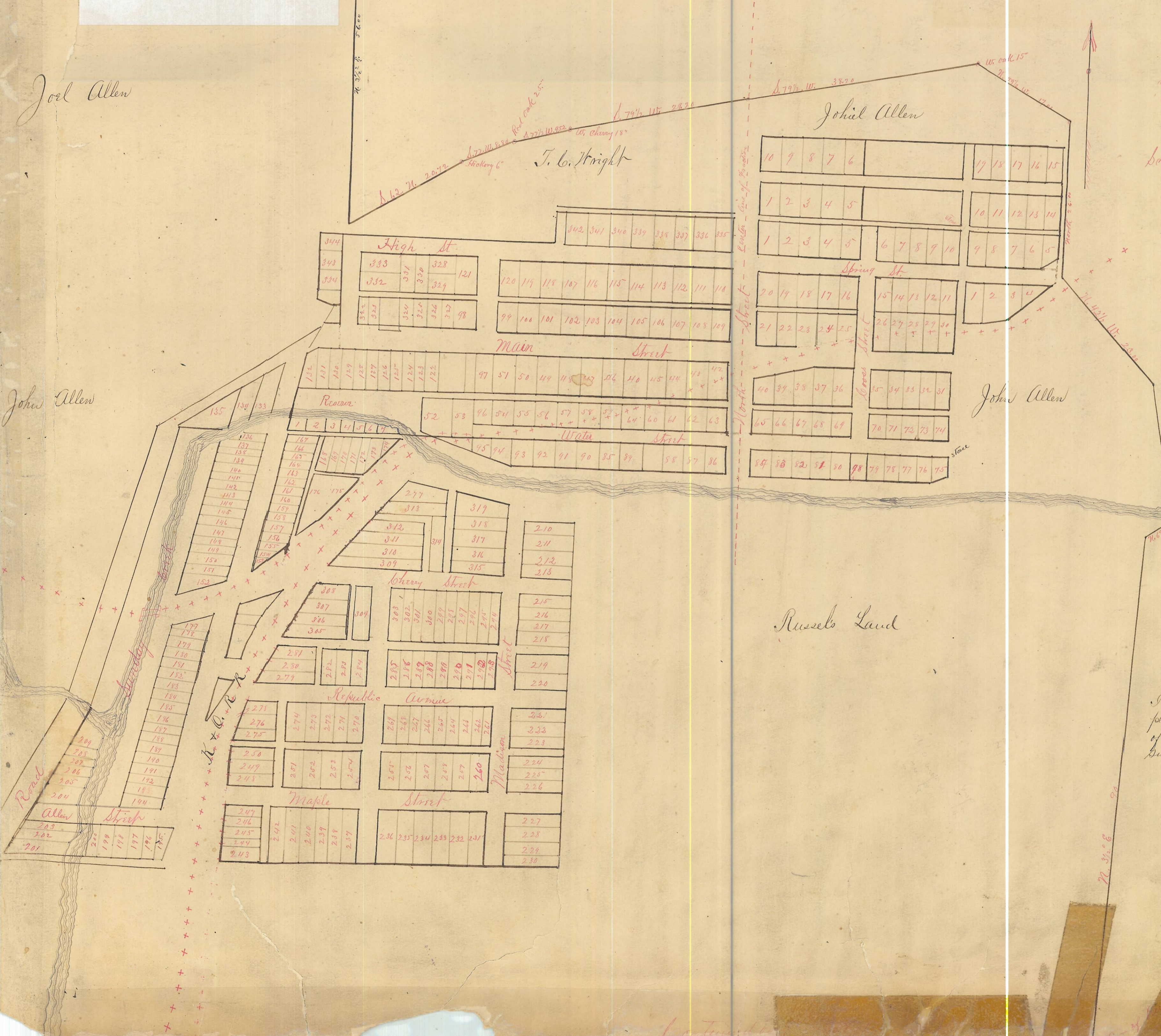

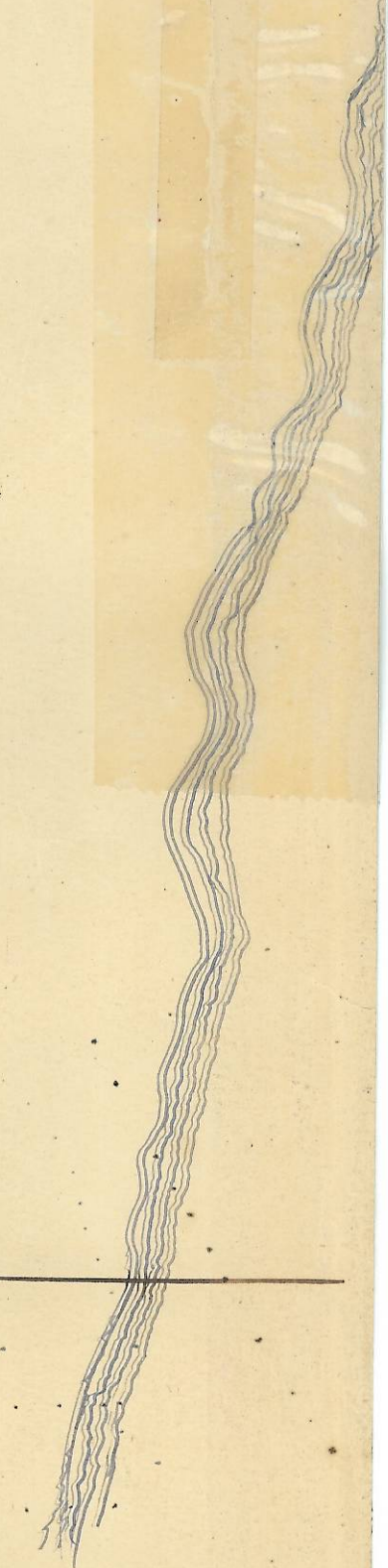
