

PETITION FOR ANNEXATION

To the Commissioners of Athens County, State of Ohio:

The undersigned, being a majority of the adult freeholders (a private corporation qualified to petition for annexation under provisions of Ohio Revised Code 709.02, 1950 Ohio Attorney General's Opinion No. 1784.) residing on the following described territory situated in the County of Athens and adjacent to the City of Athens, to-wit:

Beginning at a concrete monument on the East Corporation line of Athens, Ohio, 40 feet North of the center line of U.S. Route 50 and on the west line of Farm Lot No. 25, in Sec. No. 4, Town No. 9, Range 14, Ohio/Company's Purchase; thence along said corporation line North 5° 25' East 430.33 feet to an iron pin; (an iron pin bears south 82° 00' East 2.00 feet); thence south 82° east parallel to the north right of way line of said Highway 265.38 feet to an iron pin; thence south 5° 25' West 430.44 feet to an iron pin on the north right of way line of U.S. Route 50; (an iron pin bears South 82° 00' East 5.47 feet); thence North 82° 00' West 265.38 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.60 acres in said tract.

An accurate map of said territory is attached hereto;

Respectfully petition that the said above described territory may be annexed to the City of Athens.

And John D. Good is hereby authorized to act as agent of the

petitioners in securing such annexation.

ORDINANCE No. 1356

An Ordinance Accepting Annexation of Territory

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATHENS, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the application of Good, Inc. and others for the annexation of the following described territory in the County of Athens, and adjacent to the City of Athens, to-wit:

Beginning at a concrete monument on the East corporation line of Athens, Ohio, 40 feet North of the center line of U.S. Route 50, and on the west line of Farm Lot No. 25, in Section No. 4, Town No. 9, Range 14, Ohio Company's Purchase; thence along said corporation line North 5° 25' East 430.44 feet to an iron pin; (an iron pin bears South 82° 00' East 2.00 feet); thence south 82° east parallel to the north right of way line of said Highway 265.38 feet to an iron pin; thence south 5° 25' West 430.44 feet to an iron pin on the North right of way line of U.S. Route 50; (an iron pin bears south 82° 00' East 5.47 feet); thence North 82° 00' West 265.38 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.60 acres in said tract.

An accurate map of which territory, together with the petition for annexation, and other papers relating thereto, and a certified transcript of the proceedings of the County Commissioners in relation thereto are on file with the Clerk of the Council of said City, be and the same is hereby accepted.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
