 Is situated in Athens County, Ohio  
 Trimble Township Range 14, Fraction 3 O.C.P.  
 Description -  
 Beginning at an iron pin, set in south line  
 of Walnut Street in the village of Gloucester, said iron  
 pin bears south a distance of 1085 feet, also south  
 86 degrees west a distance of 1735 feet. From the  
 north-east corner of Fraction 3.  
 Thence South 86 degrees west on the south line  
 of Walnut Street, a distance of 205 feet to a stone.  
 Thence North 76 degrees and 30 minutes west a distance of 163 feet to  
 center of Allen Road. Thence south 33 degrees west a distance  
 of 350 feet. Thence south 12 degrees west a distance of 396 feet.  
 Thence south 1 1/2 degrees East, a distance of 176 feet. Thence North  
 87 degrees east, a distance of 549 feet. Thence North 4 1/2 degrees  
 East a distance of 790 feet to place of beginning. No. lots 1 to
