Independence is situated in the N.E. part of Fraction No 6, Town No 5, Range No 13 "O.C.P." Pierce street is 85 links wide and bears N 45° W. the lots are each 125 links wide and 200 links in length, unless their distances are noted on the plat, the lots and alleys are either parallel or at right angles with Pierce street, except the fractional lots which are bounded by the fraction lines and the Railroad. Stones are set at the N.E. corners of lots No 3, 5, 8, 7, and the S.E. corners of lots No 3, 5 & 7, also at the S.W. corner of Fraction No 12 and the N.W. corner of Fraction No 2.
