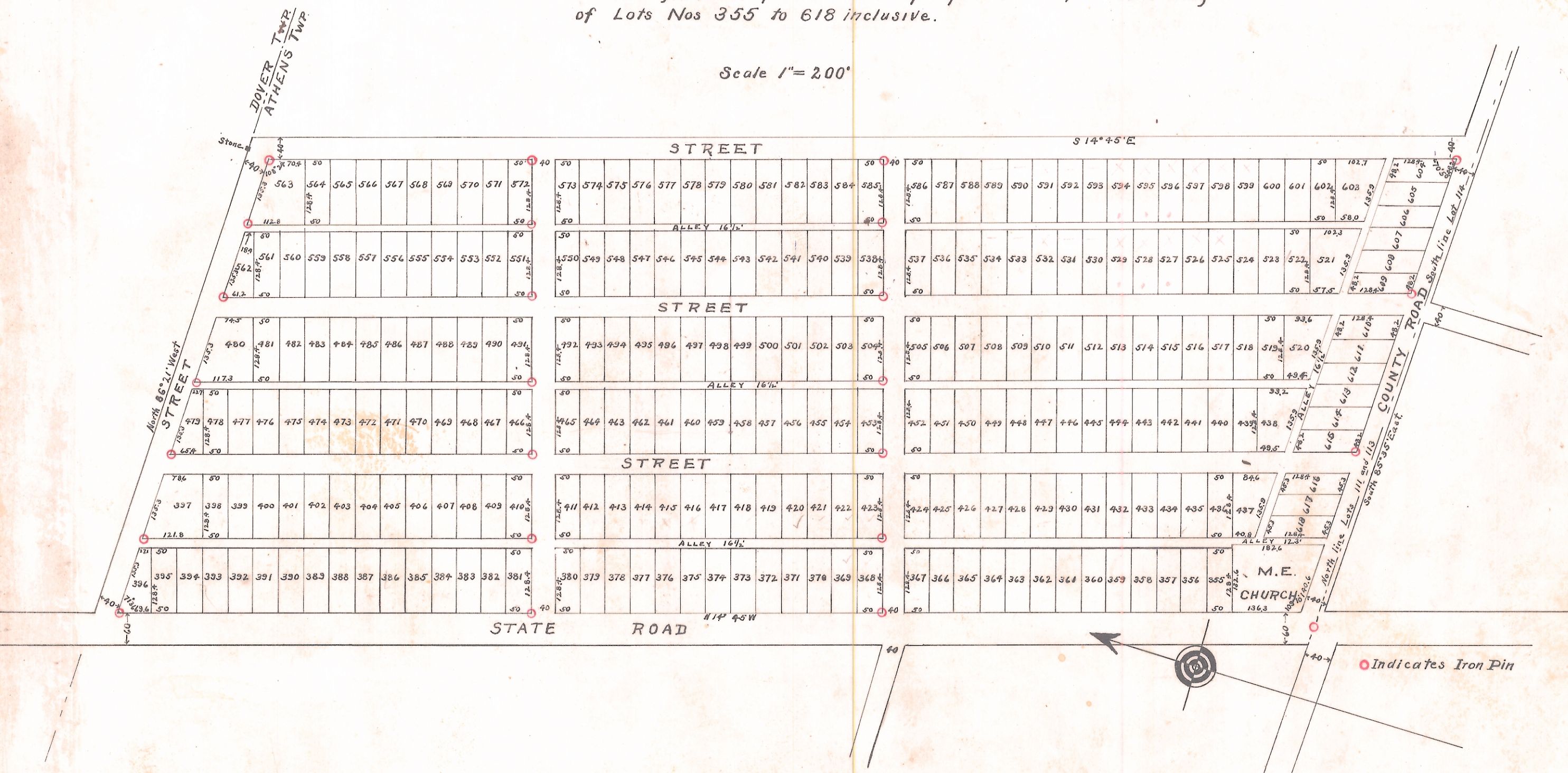


ENVELOPE: 224A
