To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners in and for the County of Athens and State of Ohio,
 your petitioners would respectfully represent to your Honorable body, 1st That they are desirous that the territory
 shown by the plat and survey filed with this petition, be organized as a body politic and incorporated as a village
 of the second class, 2nd That said territory contains about four hundred inhabitants, 3rd That said village shall be
 named "Jacksonville", 4th That we have appointed A. Koch to act as the agent of your petitioners
 A. Koch, W. C. Orew, W. G. Spierard, M. B. Freedman, A. N. Brothers, Geo. H. Vining, William Palmer,
 James Koppke, S. M. Ross, W. J. Johnston, John Sears, Geo. Goodspeed, F. S. Smith, Thomas Wayne, George Rapp,
 W. E. Williams, Robert Drose, A. C. Wolfe, A. Goodspeed, J. F. Neupston, E. F. Dauford, Frank T. Thomas

Athens, Athens County O., Sept. 8th 1885. A petition signed by the requisite number of
 electors residing within the proposed corporate limits, asking for the organization of a village to be known as Jac-
 ksonville, in Triuble Township, Athens County, Ohio, was presented, and the petitioners having complied with
 the law, therefore be it resolved that the time and place for hearing the petition, be at Athens, November 9th 1885
 Adjourned to meet December 7th 1885. December 4th 1885. In the matter of the Petition of Citizens of
 Jacksonville through their agent, A. Koch, for the Incorporation of said village, the Board of Commissioners find
 upon hearing the petition, that it contains all the matters required, and that its statements are true, that the map
 is accurate, that the persons whose names are subscribed to the petition are electors residing on the territory, that the
 notice as required has been given, that it has the requisite population for the proposed Corporation, and in all other
 matters the law has been complied with, on motion of C. D. Kean the prayer of the petition was granted by a vote
 of yeas, C. D. Kean, Joseph S. Higgins, and W. G. Kichman. I certify the above to be a correct transcript of the
 proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners of Athens County O.

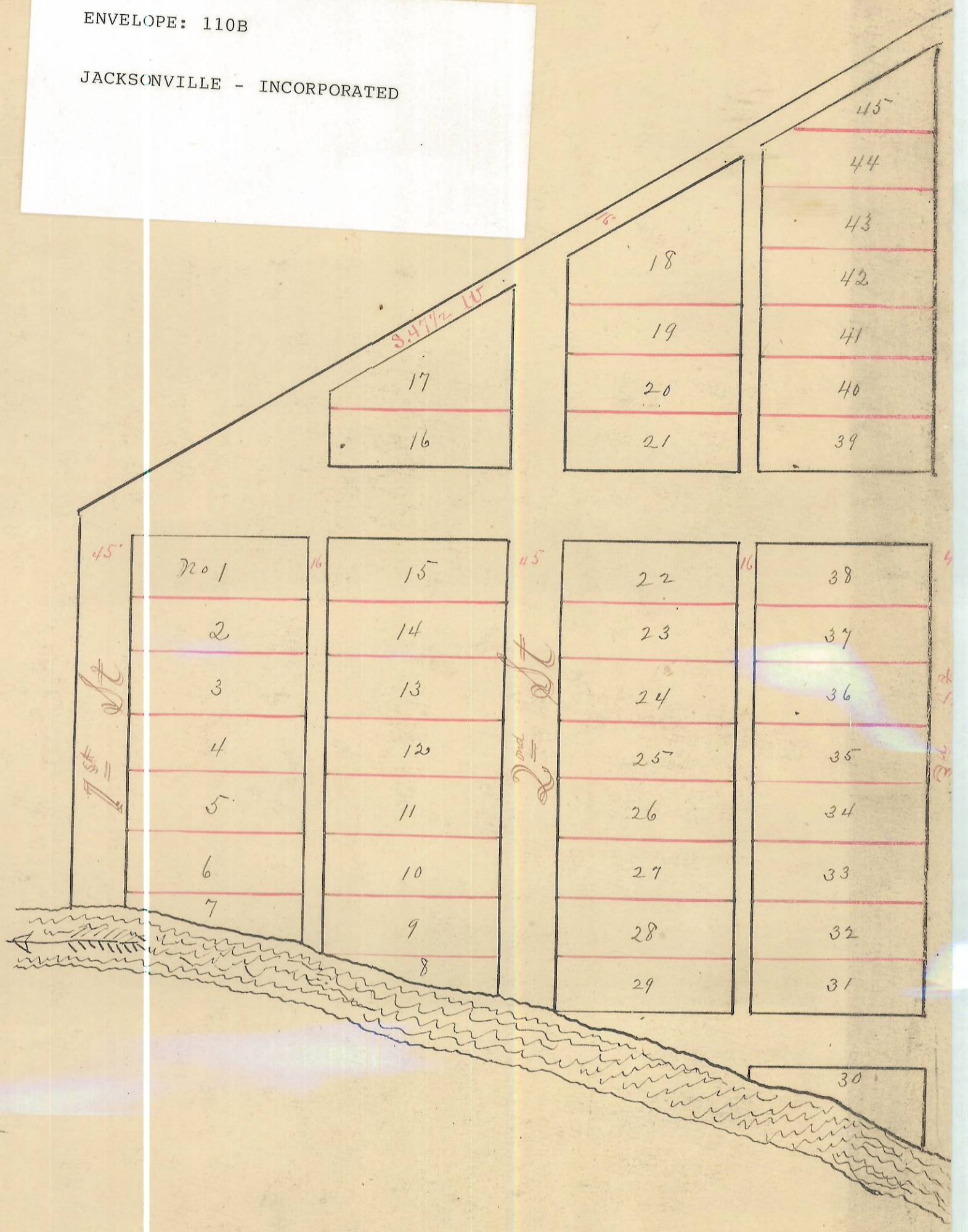
