WHEREAS, a petition for the annexation of certain territory in Canaan Township was duly filed by J. G. Hope as agent for a majority of the adult freeholders residing in the area requested to be annexed; and,

WHEREAS, the said petition was duly considered by the Board of County Commissioners of Athens County, Ohio, on December 26, 1967; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has approved the annexation of said territory to the City of Athens, as hereinafter described; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners certified the transcript of the proceedings in connection with the said annexation with the map and petition required in connection therewith to the City Auditor who received the same on December

WHEREAS, sixty (60) days from the date of said filing have now elapsed in accordance with the provisions of R.C. 709.04; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATHENS,

OHIO:

SECTION I

That the proposed annexation as applied for in the petition of J. G. Hope and a majority of freeholders residing in the territory sought to be annexed and filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Athens County, Ohio, on September 11, 1967, and which said petition prayed for annexation to the City of Athens, Ohio, of certain territory adjacent thereto, as hereinafter described, and which said petition was approved for

more than sixty (60) days.

SECTION II

That the City Auditor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to make two copies of this Ordinance to each of which shall be attached a copy of the map accompanying the petition for annexation, a copy of the transcript of proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners relating thereto and a certificate as to the correctness thereof. The City Auditor shall then forthwith deliver one copy to the County Recorder and one copy to the Secretary of State and do all things required

SECTION III

That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City for the reason to correct a situation now deemed undesirable because of insufficient fire and police protection and proper supervision of utilities; Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
