"Mr. Wakefield moved the adoption of the following resolution:  
 WHEREAS, The Commissioners of the County of Athens, State of Ohio, preceding this day to hear the petition of Claude E. and Virginia D. Kanter to obtain the annexation of the territory in their persons desiring to be heard for or against the granting of said petition and considered the affidavits presented with reference thereto, and being fully advised find that said petition contains all the matters required by law, and that its statements are true, that the territory sought to be annexed is adjacent to the said City of Athens; that the petition contains a full description of said territory; that the map of said territory attached to the petition is accurate; that said petition is signed by a majority of the adult freeholders residing on the territory sought to be annexed; that the required legal notice of the petition has been given, and that it is right and proper that said petition should be granted.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That it is hereby ordered that the prayer of said petition be granted, and that the territory described in said petition may be annexed to the City of Athens in accordance with law, and that a certified transcript signed by a majority of this Board of all the orders and proceedings of this Board relative to said petition and hearing thereon, together with said petition and map attached thereto, and all the papers on file relating to said matter be deposited at once with the Auditor of the said City of Athens.

The resolution was seconded by Mr. Edwards. The Roll being called upon its adoption the vote resulted as follows: Mr. Wakefield, yea; Mr. Edwards, yea; Mr. Hanning, yea."

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1570

To authorize annexation of certain territory to the City of Athens, Ohio.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Athens, State of Ohio:

Section I. That the annexation of the following described territory situate in Athens Township, Athens County, Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:--

Situate in Farm Lot No. 49, Section 11, Athens Township, and commencing at an iron pin which is found by running West 1240.60 feet from the Northeast corner of said Farm Lot 49 to an iron pin; thence South 7° East 1646.71 feet to an iron pin, the place of beginning; thence North 62° 29' East 397 feet to an iron pin in the center of the Peach Ridge Road; thence along the center of said Peach Ridge Road South 16° 57' East 153.30 feet to an iron pin; thence South 19° 57' East 172.57 feet to an iron pin; thence South 2° 24' West 96.25 feet to an iron pin; thence South 21° 29' West 122.90 feet to an iron pin in the center of said Peach Ridge Road at a point on the present corporation line of the said City of Athens, Ohio; thence leaving said Peach Ridge Road South 22° 14' West along the present corporation line of said City of Athens, 174.60 feet to an iron pin; thence following said corporation line South 19° 21' West 151.20 feet to an iron pin; thence South 44° 32' West 158.60 feet; thence leaving said corporation line, North 7° 0' West 468.78 feet to an iron pin; thence South 79° 32' West 208.97 feet to an iron pin; thence North 28° 28' West 106.20 feet to an iron pin; thence North 61° 30' East 265.50 feet to an iron pin and the place of beginning, containing 5.87 acres more or less.

To the City of Athens, Ohio be and the same hereby is authorized.

Section II. That the County Solicitor, William Rowland, be, and he is hereby authorized to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect such annexation.

Section III. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
