This day this cause having been duly assigned for hearing came on to be heard upon the petition of the plaintiff, the answer of the City of Athens, Ohio, consenting to the prayer of the petition, all other defendants having given their consent to vacating Piverview Drive as prayed for in the petition and join in the prayer for such vacation, and the evidence.

The Court finds that all defendants were duly and legally served with process or voluntarily entered their appearance and are properly before the Court, and that notice by publication has been given in The Athens Messenger, a newspaper of general circulation in Athens County in accordance with the provision of Section 3731 of the General Code.

abutting on said street so vacated, revert to the owner or owners of such abutting lot as a matter of law, and it is ordered that the plaintiff pay the cost of this proceeding for which judgment is rendered.
