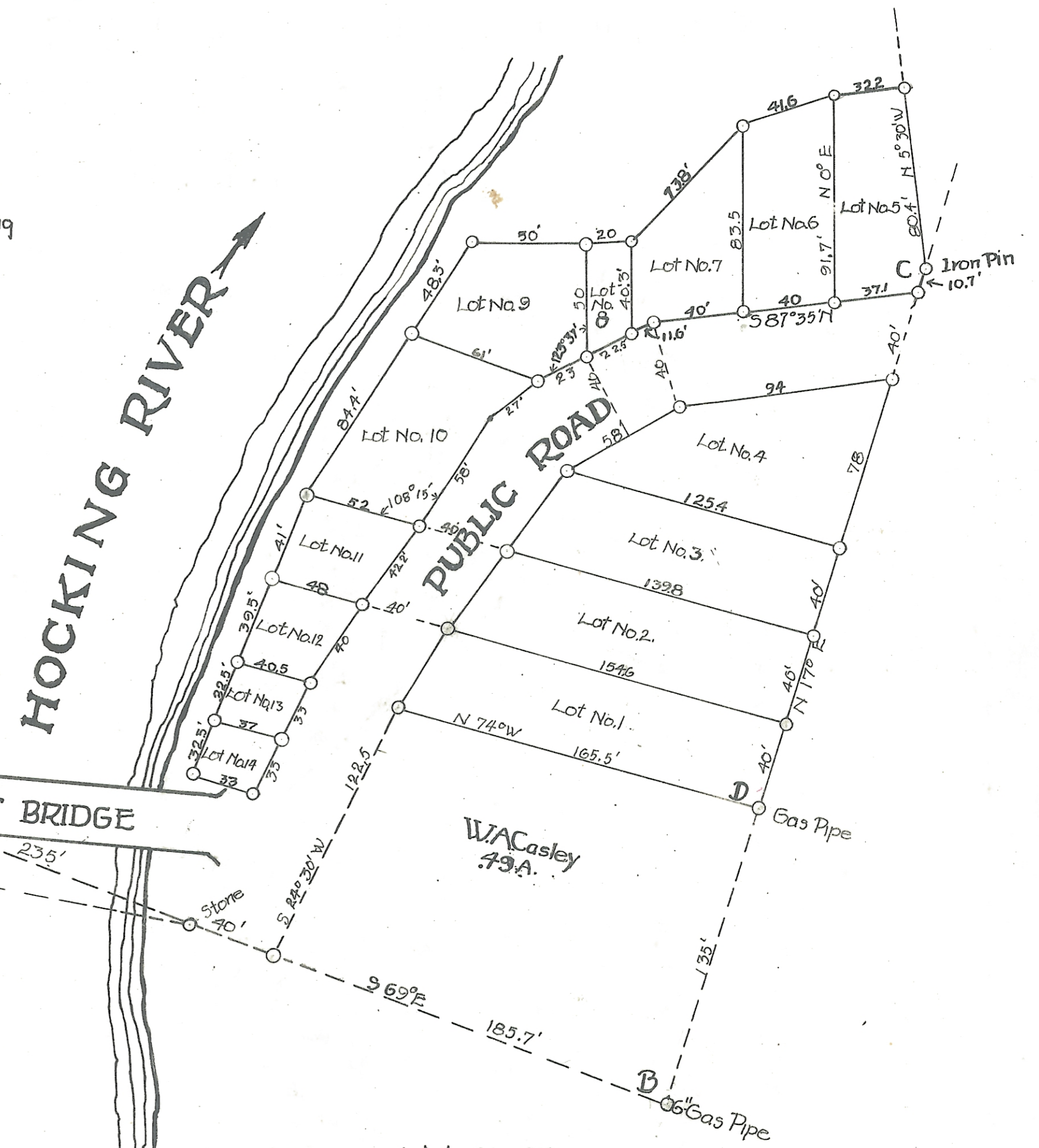
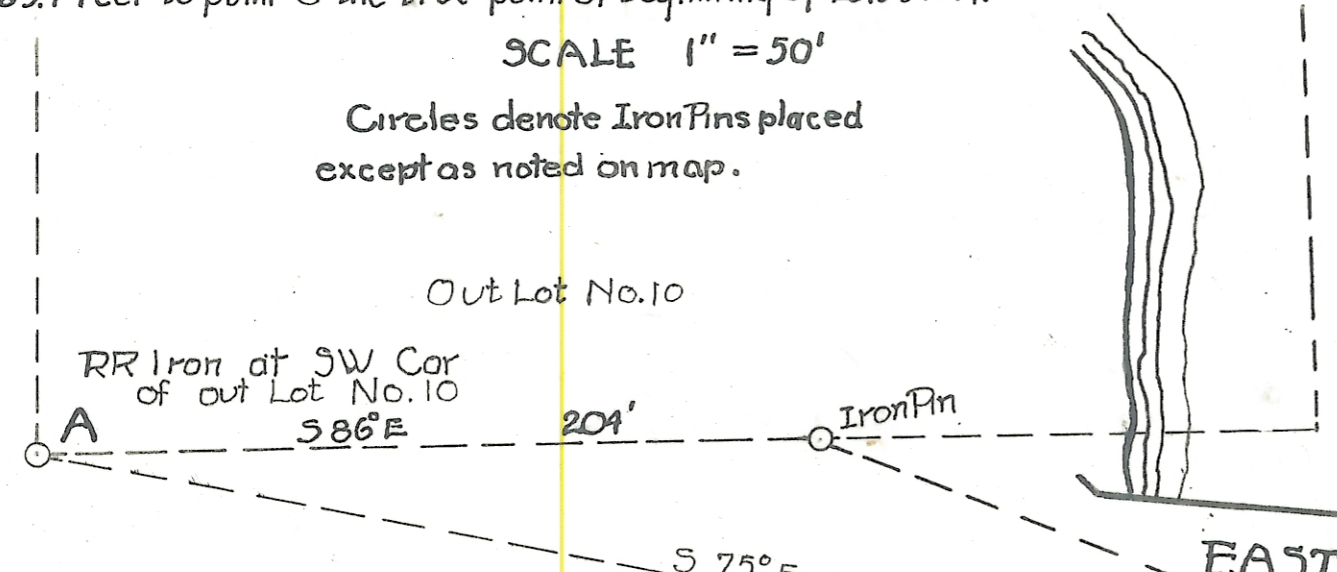
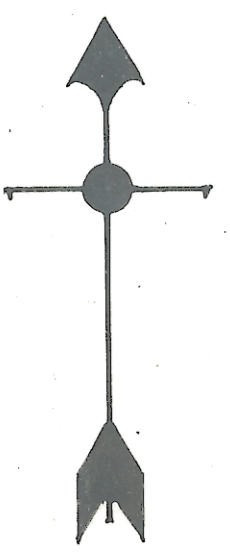

N 17° E 383.7 feet to point "C" the true point of beginning of Lots 5 to 14.
