### BOUNDRY.

Beginning at the North East corner of Out Lot 28 in the Village of Gloucester, Ohio. Thence North  $84^{\circ}30'$  East a distance of 96 ft. Thence North  $15^{\circ}30'$  West a distance of 175 ft. to the center of Sunday Creek. Thence East a distance of 258 ft. with meandering of center of Sunday Creek. Thence North  $64^{\circ}$  East a distance of 216 ft. along center of Sunday Creek. Thence North  $61^{\circ}$  East a distance of 350 ft. Thence South  $15^{\circ}30'$  East a distance of 488 ft. Thence North  $84^{\circ}30'$  East a distance of 356 ft. to the East line of Fraction 3. Thence South along East line of Fraction 3 to a stone at the South East corner of land of J. W. Allen. Thence South  $86^{\circ}$  West a distance of 940 ft. Thence North  $75^{\circ}15'$  West a distance of 510 ft.
