
Landowner Objectives

General Woodland Description

The property is located south of Athens, Ohio either side of the borderlines of Alexander and Lodi Townships, Athens County.


The current landowner is managing the property for income from timber sales and wildlife. Two small clearcut harvests have occurred on the property since being purchased to provide income and diversify wildlife habitat. Some grapevines have been cut that will promote growth and health of the forest. The woodland is fully stocked with a variety of hardwoods ranging in size from sapling to mature saw timber. Oak species and poplar dominate large sawtimber size trees with sugar maple, oak species and poplar dominating the rest of the trees. There are two small white pine plantations on the property.
