


Tina Jeffers Tract (Ladd Rd)

 If not used fro agriculture consider tree plantings


ST 17

2018, 2023, 2028	All	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	NA	Mark or remark portions of property lines (at least areas in the woods) with paint and signs to help prevent illegal trespass. remark every 5 years or as needed
2018 -2023	17	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	5ac total	Work on eradicating the Ailanthus in this area. 2 ac of heavy infestation and the remaining 3 ac light rate –cover entire area –will take work on repeated years to eradicate
2018 -2028	13	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	40+	Continue to mow field areas for pasturing/hay production purposes at least semi-annually. Work on eradicating Autumn Olive. If not used for agriculture purposes, site prep and plant area with a mixture of hwd. trees.
2019-2026	15 & 16	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	4 ac total	Cut grapevines –cover entire stands. At a minimum –cut vines out of all future “crop” trees. ie; Walnuts, Oaks, Poplars and Sugar Maples
