


Richmond Stand Map

Year(s) Suggested	Mgmt. Unit	Required Task?	Acres	Recommendations
Every 3 to 5 years as needed	All	<input type="checkbox"/>	All	Remark and then maintain property boundary line markings and corner locations
Start as soon as approved for EQIP program	All	<input type="checkbox"/>		Three years of woody invasive plant treatment of autumn olive, barberry, privet and other woody invasive plants. Consider applying for EQIP 314 to control these.
Optional	Group openings	<input type="checkbox"/>	100-200 trees	Plant a mixture of oak and hickory seedlings utilizing EQIP 612 in the group openings to supplement natural regeneration and the walnut planting. Tree shelters will be needed for deer protection. Weed, grass and brush control will help these trees survive.
After invasive control	3 and part of 1 and 2	<input type="checkbox"/>		Crop tree release/ timber stand improvement EQIP 666
Annual	All	<input type="checkbox"/>	all	Control any additional grapevines that you find growing into good trees
Optional	all	<input type="checkbox"/>	all	Cut or girdle poor quality trees that are crowding good trees. Utilize maple and other acceptable species for use as mushroom logs.
Annually	All	<input type="checkbox"/>		Monitor the stands for new invasive plants and treat when they are located.
2024 & 2029	Whole Property	<input type="checkbox"/>		Next Site Visit – Woodland reviews are recommended at least once every five years, and plan updates once every ten years, based upon the date of the last woodland evaluation conducted by your forester
