

2021, 2026, 2031	All Farm	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	NA	Inspect & remark any portions of property lines with paint and signs necessary to help prevent illegal trespass. This task must be completed before this farm is eligible for enrolment into either OFTL or CAUV forestry property tax reduction programs.
2021-2031	2	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	1+ ac	Continue to plant or just allow natural regeneration a mixture of hardwood/conifer trees & woody shrubs that are suited for soil conditions. Activities include site prep, species selection, plantings, seedling protective measures and tree care activities.
2021-2031	4	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	6 acres total	Work on releasing the walnut trees in this area by reducing osage orange trees. Possibly plant addition walnut or other nut producing trees in the area -use seedlings or nuts.
2021-2024	5 & 6	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	2-3 ac total	Treat identified Ailanthus in this area, and work on other non-native invasive species as time permits.
