remain easily visible.


Entire Farm:

This task must be completed before this farm is eligible for enrolment into either OFTL or CAUV forestry property tax reduction programs.
2019-2029	2,5,6 & 8	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	10+ ac	Continue to plant a mixture of hardwood/conifer trees & woody shrubs that are suited for soil conditions. Activities include site prep, species selection, plantings, seedling protective measures and tree care activities.
2020-2025	11	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	10+ acres total	Cut grapevines from crop trees (walnuts) at the minimum. Medium infestation rate if applying for EQIP – all vines need cut & treated, covering entire area.
