St 4 Work on eradicating the identified non-native invasive species in this area as time allows.

St 2 Cut grapevines from all "crop" trees

St 2 & 3 Possible additional selective harvesting and trail construction in this area.

St 8 Monitor WPA delgid infestation possible salvage harvest if mortality is becoming extensive.


Maintain painted property lines. Re-paint every 5 yrs or as necessary to be easily visible.

2019 -2024	4	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	28 acres total	As time permits, pick areas to work on eradicating the Bush Honeysuckle /Autumn Olive from. Annually inspect areas for other non-native invasive species like Barberry, Privet and Ailanthus.
2019 -2029	8	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	8 acres	Monitor White Pine Adelgid infestation. Possible salvage harvest if infestation causes tree mortality.
