

General Woodland Description

This property, consisting of 60 acres, is in the Village of Coolville in Athens County, to the southwest of Belpre, Ohio. The principle timber species include White Oak, Hickory, Sugar Maple and Red Oak. Yellow-Poplar, Black Oak and Sassafras, occur as associated species throughout the stands. The timber runs from seedling/sapling to medium to large sawtimber in size. The tract shows no evidence of recent fire and no significant disease problems were detected during the evaluation. However, Emerald Ash Borer has killed virtually all Ash trees within this property. In the southern stands, significant occurrences of Tree-Of-Heaven were noted, along with some grapevine.
