

### Landowner Objectives:

1. Mark all property lines with paint
2. Managed the property for long-term sustainable forest productivity.
3. Manage the forest for health growth and attributes.
4. Utilize wildlife for hunting, watching and appreciation.
5. Manage, utilize and appreciate woodland ecology including native trees, shrubs, understory plants, morel mushrooms, wild flowers, medicinal herbs and native forbs. Consider management techniques (to enhance or maintain) if unusual or valuable herbaceous plant communities or groups are found.
6. Maintain and improve access corridors.
7. Minimize soil erosion and maintain water quality.
8. Identify and manage to discourage invasive species and treat and control
9. The end goal is to manage the property for woodland products whether it is firewood in the short term or commercial timber in the long term.
