

5	3	<input type="checkbox"/>	32.02	TSI – midstory removal. Deaden cull trees (girdle and apply herbicide).
2	4	<input type="checkbox"/>	4.91	Control NNIS with herbicide.
2	5	<input type="checkbox"/>	4.91	Cut grapevines growing in AGS.
2	6	<input type="checkbox"/>	4.91	TSI - Cull tree removal.
4	7	<input type="checkbox"/>	22.42	TSI – Remove hickory UGS, crop tree release oak AGS, and deaden cull trees.

All	every 5 years	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>	<b>Next Site Visit</b> – Woodland reviews are recommended at least once every five years, and plan updates once every ten years, based upon the date of the last woodland evaluation conducted by your forester
