### Landowner Objectives


1. To manage the timber resource and maintain forest cover for both wildlife habitat and timber production.
2. To harvest timber on a timely basis, removing mature and defective and otherwise undesirable trees.
3. To maintain a simple system of access trails to all parts of the woods for management activities, wildlife viewing, hunting, and hiking.
4. To protect the watershed during all woodland activity.
5. To maintain a woodlot for future generations of family and friends to utilize and enjoy.

### *General Woodland Description*

The Woodland Renewal Society property is predominately made up of poletimber, small sawtimber, and some medium sawtimber mixed hardwoods such as sugar maple, red oak, white oak, red maple, cherry, ash, elm, sycamore, walnut, hickory, beech, aspen, yellow-poplar, and buckeye. Approximately 13 acres of softwoods (mostly white pine, some loblolly) are present and are the result of a 1997 tree planting. Previous forest management on the property also includes grapevine control in 1996. Currently, the woods would benefit from another round of grapevine control. Even though grapevine levels are low in most areas and moderate in some (western section of stand 3), they should be controlled prior to the commercial and noncommercial thinnings that will most likely take place in stands 1 and 2 in the next ten years.

### David Funk Forest Stand Type Map


