
Terrain

The Clay property is situated on level or very gently sloping ground along an unnamed stream near the headwaters of the Lake Snowden/Margaret Creek watershed and on lower, mid, and upper slopes on both sides of that stream. Most of the woods are on the east side of the stream on a west-facing slope and ridgetop (Stands 5a, 5b, 5c, 6a, 6b, 7, and most of Stand 2). These slopes are not especially steep. The remaining woods (Stands 3, 4, 5d, and part of Stand 2) surround a rounded hill situated in the southern part of the property. The Clays have built their house on the top of this hill.
