

The goal of implementing Management Recommendations such as Grapevine Control and Crop Tree Release, Etc., is to maximize the production of desirable tree species, but, if the landowner chooses to do nothing, the forested acreage listed within this management plan will continue to produce timber.

Before entering a timber sale agreement or conducting other forestry work that is not listed in your activity schedule, contact your forester first to ensure compliance with your approved forest management plan.
