

General Woodland Description

Dominant tree species include yellow poplar, red & sugar maple, red, black, white & scarlet oaks, aspen, red pine, walnut and others can also be found. Tree size ranges from poletimber and small sawtimber, with scattered medium sawtimber and widely scattered large sawtimber. Grapevine control needs to be implemented. Invasive plant species are not a problem at this time. The Emerald Ash Borer has infected ash, although very few ash were observed.
