

### *General Woodland Description*

Dominant tree species include yellow poplar, red maple, and black oak. Chestnut oak, white oak, scarlet oak, sugar maple, hickory, aspen can also be found throughout the stand. Tree size ranges from sapling to small sawtimber with scattered medium sawtimber and widely scattered large sawtimber. Implementing grapevine control will enhance the health and quality of crop trees.
