
Landowner Objectives

General Woodland Description

Danny Bailey purchased this property 10 years ago. Since then, the property has been managed for timber and wildlife. Bailey has been cutting grapevines and treating non-native invasive species in accordance with his previous management plan. This property was harvested right before Danny purchased the property. The increase in light released non-native invasive species such as ailanthus, princess tree, autumn olive and multiflora rose. For the last ten years treatments of these species have ensued. The battle is not over and there are still patches that need treated. The timber consists of mostly young sawtimber size trees. Hard maple, red oak, white oak, walnut, hickory, buckeye dominate the property. This timber is currently healthy and growing well.

Bailey Stand Map




