
1. Improve the growth and productivity of stands for future timber production.

### *General Woodland Description*

This property, consisting of 206.92 acres, is in the Troy Township of Athens County, to the south-west of Belpre, Ohio. Athens County, part of the unglaciated Allegheny Plateau Region, is comprised of 322,560 acres, nearly 56 percent of which is forest. Most of the woodland on the tract are in areas of steep soils. The major forest types identified throughout include Mixed Oak/Hickory, Appalachian Mixed Hardwoods, Successional, Virginia Pine and Upland Hardwoods.



