

General Woodland Description

This forested property is located within the township of Glouster, Athens County, Ohio. This upland forest includes one stand that has been clear cut of mature Virginia pine and Aspen in 2008. The remaining stands received a commercial thinning by single tree selection in 2008 as well. The woodlands are in good condition, with dense foliage throughout the property. There are many Northern Hardwoods and Upland species of Uneven age's and young evergreens are present on this property providing diversity for various wildlife.
