### *Landowner Management Objectives*

1. Protect & manage the property for all attributes and opportunities that exist in a forest ecosystem of interest to the owner including recreation, wildlife management, soil and water management, forest protection, timber products management, and other compatible conservation uses.
2. Improve the overall condition of the woodlands by cutting grapevines allowing timber to mature into large sawlog sized trees.

### *General Woodland Description*

Athens County is located in the unglaciated hill country of southeastern Ohio. Slope and erosion hazard is the major land use limitations. Seasonal wetness, droughtiness, flood hazard, and the moderately slow to very slow permeability of some soils also limit land use.

Athens County is in the central hardwood forest region. Most of the woodland in Athens County is in areas of steep and very steep terrain. This terrain is well suited to trees.


Kevin & Janelle purchased this tract in February of 2000. Property lines were surveyed at time of purchase with corned marker established. Kevin began cutting grapevines and do some thinning work. The issue to this tract is access off State Route 691. This area is a steep bank and limited parking space. A timber harvest was prepared in 2011 but because of market conditions, was not sold. After Kevin & Janelle purchased their Lodi Twp. farm and built a house on that tract, this parcel has had limited use. This tract may be disposed of at some point in time. This is currently an investment and being retained in a natural state.
