

1. Enjoy the woodlands for the recreational opportunities it provides.
2. Reduce property taxes by doing the necessary work required to qualify for the CAUV property tax program.
3. Conduct long term management for the future quality of the woodland.
4. Maintain wildlife habitat diversity across the property.
5. To maintain a simple system of access trails for recreation and management activities.
6. To remove dead ash and oak for firewood as needed
7. To leave the woodland in better condition for future generations
8. To use cultural treatments to facilitate ecosystem restoration and enhancement, including invasive and undesirable plant control
9. To create forest products for harvest and income
