


Stand Map

Year Suggested	Mgmt. Unit	Acres	Recommendations
2025-2035	All	53.975	Let Grow
2025-2027	All	53.975	Cut and spray multiflora rose, bush honeysuckle and autumn olive
2025-2027	All	53.975	Cut grapevines
2025-2035	All	53.975	Monitor for and treat other invasive species
2025	All	53.975	Update Boundary Marking
2030	A	22.3	Evaluate for potential improvement harvest
2035	Whole Property	All	Next Site Visit 2035 – (Woodland reviews need completed at least every ten years or sooner if needed).
