RESOLUTION NO. 722

A RESOLUTION ABANDONING TWENTY FEET OFF THE WEST SIDE OF ADAMS STREET AND TO  
 DECLARE AN AMERGENCY

WHEREAS Adams Street was originally platted as being sixty-six feet in width, and  
 WHEREAS six feet of the East side thereof for curb, the next twenty-six feet  
 to the West was used as paved road, the next fourteen feet lies unused and the west most  
 twenty feet has been encroached upon by divers lot owners and houses built thereon, and  
 WHEREAS, it is desired to clear the title to certain properties built upon said street and  
 to make the plat of said City conform to the actual usage of said sixty-six feet and to clear  
 title to properties adjacent thereto, now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NELSONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the City of Nelsonville abandons, and does hereby abandon, the  
 Western most twenty feet of Adams Street extending from Parkway Drive to Franklin Street,  
 and does hereby convey to each of the lot owners adjacent thereto, all of the right, title  
 and interest of the city in and to said abandoned portion to the adjacent title holders of  
 record this date.

Section 2. From and after the date of this Resolution the established width of Adams  
 Street shall be forty-six feet throughout its course from Parkway Drive to Franklin  
 Street, said forty-six feet to be measured from the East street line, the Grade thereof  
 to be established as it presently is maintained.

Section 3. That the Clerk of this Council be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed  
 to certify a copy of this Resolution together with a plat attached thereto to the Auditor  
 and Recorder of Athens County, Ohio, for recordation.

Section 4. For the reason that it is desired to clear the title to the adjacent property  
 as expeditiously as possible, this Resolution is declared to be an emergency resolution  
 necessary for the public peace, health and safety and shall take effect immediately upon  
 its adoption.
