

Said petition is accompanied by an accurate map of the territory to be incorporated as a village, or statement of the supposed number of inhabitants residing in the proposed incorporation; a request that the name of the incorporated village be Amersoll. the name of J. W. Gibson of Amersoll Ohio, as the agent of the petitioners, and a request of the petitioners that an election be held to obtain the sense of an electors on such incorporation.

The Trustees thereupon received such petition, together with the evidence and proof that the persons who signed it are electors and that they reside within the limits of the proposed incorporation; that the majority of such petitioners are freeholders, and the Trustees said there upon make and declare that such territory shall, with the assent of the qualified voters thereof obtain according to law, be an incorporated village by the name of Amersoll, which name is specified in the petition aforesaid.

The Trustees of said Township thereupon give notice of an election by the qualified voters, residents in said territory, to be held at the Town Hall in Amers Township Athens County Ohio, upon the 5th day of November 1900, said day being within 15 days after the receipt of said petition by said Trustees, to determine whether such territory shall be incorporated, and it is further ordered that ten days notice of such election shall be given by publication in the Athens Messenger & Herald, a newspaper of general circulation in such territory, and that three notices thereof be posted in three public places in said territory to be incorporated: - to-wit: one at Post Office; one at W. H. Burfurnan's store window, and at F. W. Gibsons store window.

The Board of Trustees of Amers Township, Athens County Ohio, met in called session on date, present Daniel Fleming, J. B. Johnson and W. C. Hill Trustees, aforesaid. H. H. Henry, Clerk.

In the matter of the incorporation of the territory described in the petition and map heretofore presented by the residents of said territory to the said Trustees of Amers Township, the said Trustees do find that an election was held by the electors of said territory to determine whether such territory shall be incorporated in accordance with the notice of election previously given at the time and place in said notice named. at which election said Township Trustees were Judges, and the Township Clerk was Clerk thereof, and they do find from a canvass of the returns of said Judge and Clerk, that the number of votes cast at said election were 69, that the number cast for incorporation were 37, and that the number cast against incorporation were 32 and that a majority of the votes cast thereat was in favor of incorporation.

The said Trustees declare that said territory from this time shall be deemed an incorporated village, and it is thereupon by the Trustees of Amers Township, Athens County Ohio, ordered and declared that the territory described in said petition heretofore submitted to said Trustees by the inhabitants thereof be and the same is hereby incorporated as a village by the name of Amersoll; that a certified transcript of the Journal entered in this matter by us had together with the original petition and map be and the same is hereby certified.
