Commencing at a set iron pin the northeast corner of said Farm Lot 2; thence on an assumed bearing South 65 degrees 42 minutes 11 seconds West 1085.94 feet to a found iron pin the southeast corner of a tract described in Volume 256 Page 176 and Volume 257 Page 1 of the Athens County Deed Records, said pin is also the southeast corner of Lot 6 in the Vacated William's Subdivision described in Plat Book 7 Page 319 of the Athens County Recorder's Office and said pin is THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence South 04 degrees 37 minutes 45 seconds West 170.92 feet to a found iron pin on the northerly boundary of a 1.58 acre tract described in Volume 370 Page 493 of the Athens County Deed Records; thence along said northerly boundary North 61 degrees 06 minutes 25 seconds West 170.24 feet to a found iron pin; thence North 77 degrees 59 minutes 46 seconds West 59.02 feet to a found railroad spike in Athens County Road 19 the northwest corner of said 1.58 acre tract; thence along said road North 12 degrees 00 minutes 11 seconds East 119.96 feet to a point; thence leaving said road and along the south property line of aforementioned Lot 6 South 78 degrees 01 minutes 08 seconds East (passing a found iron pin at 31.00 feet) for a total distance of 199.98 feet to the point of beginning and containing 0.6612 acre and being part of a tract described in Volume 368 Page 411 by which grantor claims title.
