2. South 17°36'50" West 69.56 feet to a point; thence
3. South 37°22'54" West 61.19 feet to a point; thence
4. South 50°58'48" West 77.36 feet to a point; thence
5. South 53°04'29" West 96.51 feet to a point; thence
6. South 52°45'06" West 110.04 feet to a point; thence leaving the said Athens County Road 21 and along the grantors west property line North 00°06'05" West 371.69 feet to a point on the north line of aforesaid Lease Lot 2; thence along the north line of said Lease Lot 2 and the grantors north property line South 88°59'16" East 298.78 feet to the point of beginning containing 1.682 acres and being part of a 41 acre tract described as the fourth tract in Volume 227 Page 137 of the Athens County Deed Records.

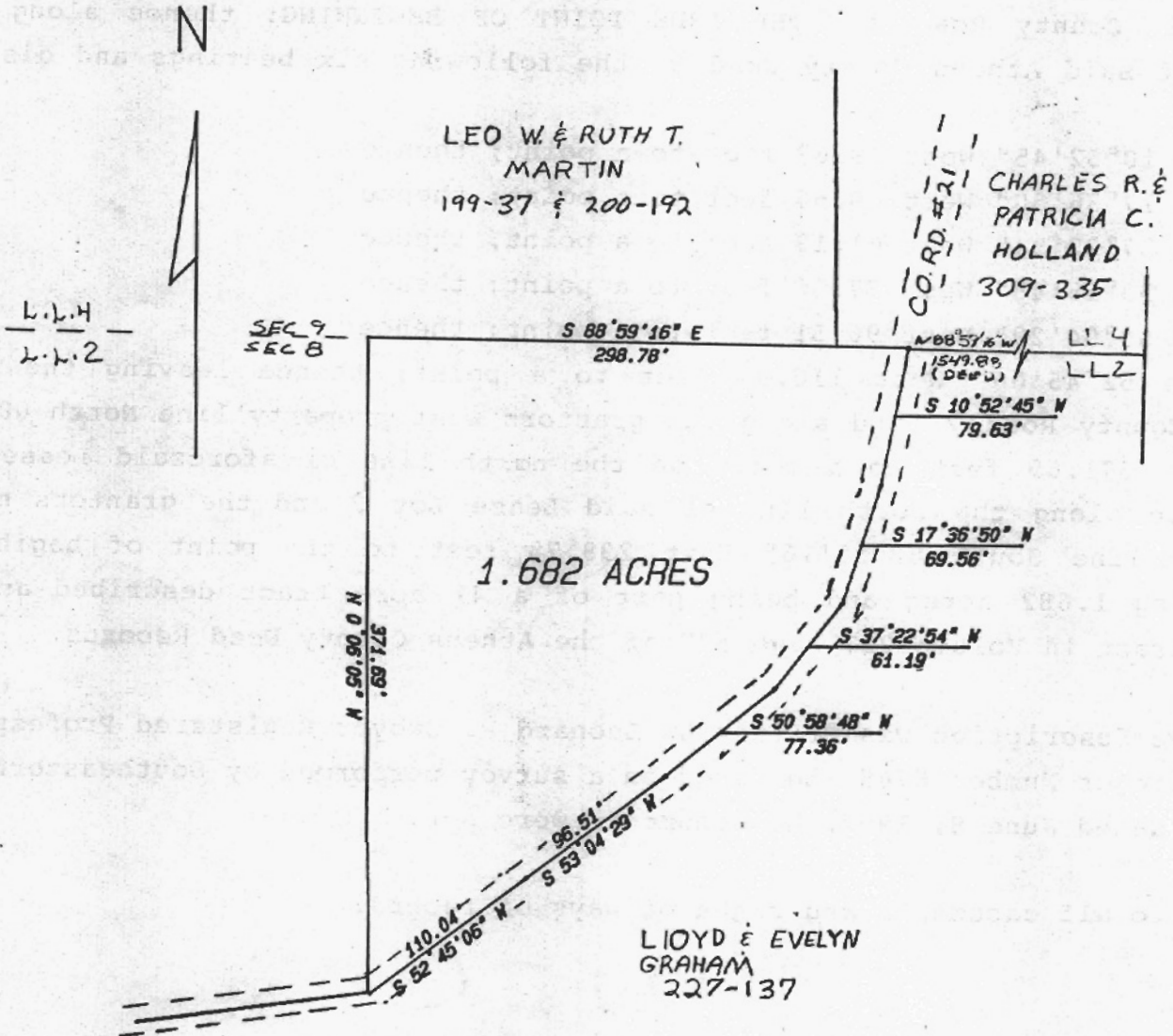
