



## SOUTHEASTERN LAND SURVEYS

Situated in the north half of Section 11, Town 6, Range 13, Ames Township, Athens County, Ohio and described as follows:

Commencing at a fence post corner at the estimated center of said Section 11; thence along the existing fence line on an assumed bearing North 82 degrees 57 minutes 21 seconds West, a distance of 317.97 feet to a point in the center of State Route 329, THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence along the center of said State Route 329 North 4 degrees 07 minutes 02 seconds West, a distance of 5.37 feet to a point; thence North 3 degrees 17 minutes 54 seconds West, a distance of 84.63 feet to a point; thence leaving the said State Route 329 South 83 degrees 11 minutes 36 seconds East (passing a set iron pin at 27.00 feet) for a total distance of 298.14 feet to a set iron pin; thence North 5 degrees 44 minutes 26 seconds West, a distance of 212.76 feet to a set iron pin on the south line of a 13.77 acre tract described in Volume 163 Page 849 of the Athens County Official Deed Records; thence along the said south line South 86 degrees 18 minutes 00 seconds East, a distance of 99.44 feet to a set iron pin at the southeast corner of said 13.77 acre tract; thence along the east line of said 13.77 acre tract North 7 degrees 30 minutes 28 seconds East. a distance of 146.52 feet to a set iron pin; thence leaving the east line of said 13.77 acre tract South 82 degrees 57 minutes 21 seconds East, a distance of 432.67 feet to a set iron pin; thence South 18 degrees 38 minutes 50 seconds West, a distance of 458.94 feet to a set iron pin; thence North 82 degrees 57 minutes 21 seconds West along an arbitrary line and the north line of a 95.90 acre tract described in Volume 326 Page 691 of the Athens County Deed Records (passing the estimated center of Section 11 at 357.67 feet and a set iron pin at 644.89 feet) for a total distance of 675.64 feet to the point of beginning and containing 5.0678 acres, and being a part of the second tract described in Volume 299 Page 45 of the Athens County Deed Records.
