Beginning at a point in the center of State Route 690 and Dutch Creek Road intersection, where a 18 " Beech at the southeast corner of Section 13 bears S 10 03' 05" E a distance of 1296.56 feet, THENCE along the center of State Route 690 the following three (3) coyrses, S $3731^{\prime} 37^{\prime \prime}$ E a distance of 89.62 feet to a point; THENCE S $411^{\prime} 48^{\prime \prime}$ E a distance of 63.93 feet to a point; THENCE S 43 16' $07^{\prime \prime}$ E a distance of 87.95 feet to a point; THENCE leaving the center of State Route 690 and along the south lines of Jerry Burleson, OR 420-2418 and the north lines of Abbott Smith, OR 295-1771, S 65 20' $25^{\prime \prime}$ W a distance of 483.77 feet to a $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ capped rebar set, passing a $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ capped rebar set at 29.95 feet; THENCE S $8451^{\prime} 46^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ a distance of 209.88 feet to a $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ capped rebar set; THENCE S $6051^{\prime} 46^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ a distance of 330.00 feet to a $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ capped rebar set at a corner of Paul M. Freedman, Official Record 417-1684; THENCE along the east side of Paul Freeland, OR 4171684, N $3604^{\prime} 02^{\prime \prime}$ W a distance of 157.15 feet to a point in the center of the new relocated Dutch Creek Road, Township Road 34, passing a 5/8", capped rebar set at 107.22 feet; THENCE along the center of Dutch Creek Road the following four (4) courses, N 69 29' $21^{\prime \prime}$ E a distance of 299.05 feet to a point where a iron pin found on the south right of way of Dutch Creek Road bears S 2304 '58" E a distance of 30.03 feet; THENCE N $6420^{\prime} 44^{\prime \prime}$ E a distance of 142.85 feet to a point where a iron pin found on the south right of way of Dutch Creek Road bears S 27 49' 01" E a distance of 30.02 feet; THENCE N $6001^{\prime} 13^{\prime \prime}$ E a distance of 416.60 feet to a point where a iron pin found on the south right of way of Dutch Creek Road bears S 29 58' $47^{\prime \prime}$ E a distance of 30.00 feet; THENCE N $5836^{\prime} 13^{\prime \prime}$ E a distance of 120.35 feet to the Point of Beginning, containing 3.8589 Acres.
