

DESCRIPTION OF A 7.313 ACRE TRACT

Situated in Fraction 13, Section 14, T.6, R.13, Ames Township, Athens County, Ohio and being a part of the First Parcel of the Second Tract and part of the Second Parcel as recorded in Volume 294, Page 1658 of the Official Records of Athens County and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in State Route 550, said point bears East 1180 feet more or less and South 80 degrees 02 minutes 47 seconds East, 3600 feet more or less from the North-west corner of Fraction 13;

Thence, leaving said road and along new lines created by this survey:

S 22° 52' 21" E, 746.83 feet to an iron pin set, passing an iron pin set at 83.43 feet;

S 24° 26' 51" W, 269.12 feet to an iron pin set;

N 51° 28′ 48″ W, 790.99 feet to a point in State Route 550, passing an iron pin set at 770.66 feet:

Thence, along said road,

N 44° 57′ 57″ E, 622.57 feet to the point of beginning and containing 7.313 acres.

Subject to all easements and rights of way of record.

Iron pins set are 5/8" by 30 " long rebar

Bearings: Grid North N.A.D. 83
