Being a part of the 4.662 acre tract of land that is now or formerly in the name of Citizens Bank of Logan as recorded in Official Record 139 at page 177, Athens County Recorder's Office, said tract being situated in Section 11, Athens Township, T9N, R14W, Athens County, City of Athens, State of Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning, for reference, at a stone on the southeast corner of Farm Lot 68 as referenced in Official Record 90 at page 958 and on the north line of Farm Lot 50;

Thence along the north line of Farm Lot 50, North 84 degrees 50 minutes West a distance of 741.30 feet, (O.R. 90 at page 958), to a point being centerline Station 101+98.5 of Old U.S. Rt. 33 known as Columbus Road;

Thence along the center of said road, South 38 degrees 30 minutes East a distance of 1730.50 feet, (O.R. 90 at page 958), to a point being centerline Station 84+68 and a corner to a 1.24 acre tract as recorded in Official Record 82 at page 749;

Thence leaving the center of said road and along the northwesterly line of said 1.24 acre tract, North 51 degrees 30 minutes East a distance of 270.00 feet to an iron pipe found on the corner to the 1.24 acre tract and the principal place of beginning for the tract herein described;

Thence North 51 degrees 30 minutes East a distance of 156.72 feet to a 5/8" iron pin with a plastic identification cap set on the grantor's easterly line;

Thence along the grantor's easterly line, South 29 degrees 46 minutes East, passing through an iron pipe found at 44.84 feet, going a total distance of 202.34 feet to a drill hole in concrete found on the northerly line of a 50.0 foot public right of way and the grantor's southeasterly corner;

Thence along the grantor's southerly line and along said public right of way line, South 51 degrees 30 minutes West a distance of 126.00 feet to an iron pipe found being a corner to the previously mentioned 1.24 acre tract;

Thence leaving said right of way line and along the northeasterly line of the 1.24 acre tract, North 38 degrees 30 minutes West a distance of 200.00 feet to the principal place of beginning, containing 0.6490 acre, more or less, and subject to all easements of record.
