Commencing at the northeast corner of said Outlot 106, on the south line of Union Street and the west line of Depot Street; thence along the east line of said Outlot 106 and the west line of Depot Street on an assumed bearing South 00°22'50" west 294.76 feet to a found iron pin at the southeast corner of a 0.97 acre tract described in Volume. 381 Page 387 of the Athens County Deed Records and on the north right of way line of the C.S.X. railroad, said found iron pin is THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence continuing along the east line of Outlot 106 and west line of Depot Street South 00°22'50" West 85.75 feet to a set iron pin at the northeast corner of a 1.71 acre tract described in Volume 1 Page 220 of the Athens County Official Deed Records and south right of way line of the C.S.X. railroad; thence leaving the east line of Outlot 106 and west line of Depot Street and along the north line of said 1.71 acre tract and the north line of a 0.77 acre tract described in Volume 1 Page 220 of the Athens County Official Deed Records and the south line of the C.S.X. railroad the following three bearings and distances:

- 1) North 89°37'06" West 10.27 feet to a set iron pin; thence
- 2) North 57°22'13" West (passing the northwest corner of said 1.71 acre tract at 387.98 feet) for a total distance of 425.84 feet to a set iron pin; thence
- 3) North 55° 16' 16" West 214.04 feet to a point on the east line of the Athens Lumber Company property described in Volume 67 Page 494 of the Athens County Deed Records; thence along the east line of said Athens Lumber Company property North 00°10'08" East 31.58 feet to a point at the northeast corner of said property and being on the south line of Union Street; thence along the south line of Union Street South 89°43'02" East 89.93 feet to a found iron pin on the north right of way line of aforesaid C.S.X. railroad; thence leaving the south right of way line of Union Street and along the north right of way of said railroad along a curve to the left having a radius of 2,846.90 feet the long chord of which bears South 55° 44' 28" East 161.94 feet to a set railroad spike thence continuing along said north railroad right of way line South 57°22'15" East 381.76 feet to the point of beginning and containing 1.091 acres of which 0.32 acres are in Outlot 84 and 0.777 acres are in Outlot 106 and being a part of a tract of land described in Volume 54 Page 28 and Volume 94 Page 589 of the Athens County Deed Records.
